RESIDENCY VALIDATION

In order to enroll a child in a public school system in Virginia, state law requires a parent or guardian of a child to provide certain information to the child's school division. When a student is being registered in Bedford County Public Schools for the first time and each time there is a change of address it is required that the parent or guardian present reasonable proof of residing in our school district.

Parents or legal guardians who reside with their child in a property that they <u>own</u> will fill out the <u>Residency Validation form</u>. Parents or legal guardians who reside with their child in a property that they or <u>rent</u> will fill out the <u>Residency Validation form and provide the acceptable documentation</u>. Acceptable documentation includes a copy of a mortgage, lease, or real estate tax statement of your <u>principal</u> residence in Bedford County.

False statements of Residency: § 22.1-264.1 of Virginia legal code. A parent or guardian can be charged with a Class 4 misdemeanor for knowingly making a false statement concerning the residency of a child in a particular school division or school attendance zone if the purpose is to avoid tuition or to enroll the student in a school outside the attendance zone in which the student resides.

I am aware of this procedure, which states that if a student is found to have established residency in our attendance area by using false or inaccurate information, the student will be immediately withdrawn from school; and by Virginia High School regulations, the student will lose extracurricular eligibility for 365 days from the date the information is certified as being false (VHSL Regulation 30-5-3.) Furthermore, the parents will be required to pay all non-residency fees incurred while the student was enrolled in Bedford County Public Schools.
